

## BMT and COVID-19 -- Revised

### At the CUBE

- Prior to leaving home, volunteers are encouraged to do a health check at home. If someone has any inkling of illness, please practice common sense and stay home if any of these symptoms are detected.
  - Fever or chills
  - Cough
  - Shortness of breath
  - Difficulty breathing
  - Fatigue
  - Muscle or body aches
  - Headache
  - New loss of taste or smell
  - Sore throat
  - Congestion or runny nose
  - Nausea or vomiting
  - Diarrhea
- Volunteers will gather at the Cube parking lot on Saturday morning, August 1, remaining inside their cars.
- Social distancing will be expected.
- Properly worn masks are required if you leave your vehicle.
- Registration is encouraged well ahead of the workday but can be completed on August 1.
- Registration will begin at 7:00am. Music and worship begins at 7:30. Scattering to job sites will take place at 8:00am. Volunteers will remain inside their cars for this gathering activity.
- Individuals will pick up food bags as they drive into the parking lot.
- Team Leaders will pick up Team Leader kits, t-shirts, yard signs, etc. when entering the parking lot.
- Bring your own water for the entire day.

### At the work sites

- Teams are permitted to work inside or outside the home with permission of the homeowner. Team leaders should contact the homeowner in advance to ascertain the homeowner's comfort level with volunteer involvement.
- Groups will be limited to a maximum of 10 volunteers with a maximum of 2 volunteers working together inside the home on tasks.
- Social distancing will be expected.
- Properly worn masks are required inside and out.
- Homeowners are required to wear masks in the presence of volunteer workers.
- Persons are encouraged to bring their own masks and hand sanitizer although BMT will provide some for each team if desired.
- If work is done inside, it is a best practice to clean surfaces in the work area before leaving. Work with the homeowner ahead of the workday to plan the cleaning requirements of the homeowner, and who will provide the cleaning supplies such as wipes, sprays and/or paper towels.
